**Description:** Having completed four full interior renovations for homeowners at Villager Townhomes plus an exterior renovation for the entire property, the founders of Rowland+Broughton Architecture and Urban Design had become intimately familiar with the building. When the opportunity arose to acquire one of the units the duo jumped at the opportunity. The complete renovation of their space gave them the chance to test out new sustainable concepts and materials. Walls are insulated with recycled denim and FSC certified lumber is used for framing. Wood floors and millwork throughout is created with FSC certified wood and non-formaldehyde glue. New energy efficient mechanical equipment, lighting, and energy star appliances replace outdated ones. Sustainable interior finishes sweep through the space in a consistent spa-inspired palette that brings serenity to every day life.

- All rift sawn white oak used for millwork, floors & doors is FSC certified

- Dual flush toilets used throughout
- Insulation in all walls made from recycled blue jeans
- Tile in bathrooms contains post consumer recycled content
- Energy efficient lighting, the majority of the home uses fluorescent and LED
- Designed to allow natural light to flow through the spaces reducing the dependency on artificial lighting
- Urban location walk to everything!

Above The offset fireplace is original to the space and is accentuated with a custom metal surround by Infinity Iron and a precast concrete hearth. A glass door pockets back when not in use.

**Right** The kitchen is relocated to utilize the space in the open upper level more efficiently.




Left Walls around the stair are replaced with steel rails to allow natural daylight to flood the space, and contribute to the airy feeling of the upper level. Custom Beam chaise lounges from Shimna, coffee table from CB2 and felted carpet tiles from FLOR room.

Below Left An upholstered builtin banquette, custom oak dining table and Saarinen chairs from Knoll create a cozy dining space where the kitchen originally stood.

Below Right Rowland and Broughton enjoying their own piece of Villager Townhomes,

Bottom Right Built-in seating extends the living space onto the deck off of the living room. Outdoor cushions from West Elm add comfort.





Above The vocabulary of the interior design continues into the private spaces. Custom platform bed and nightstands in white oak speak directly with the millwork of the same material in the master bath. The felted wool upholstered headboard has a glowing halo from a hidden LED light source.

Far Left In the master bath, a precast concrete countertop features an integral two-person trough sink and faucets from Grohe. The steam shower visible in the reflection of the mirror utilizes unglazed porcelain tile with post consumer recycled content and has a recessed shower head with integral LED lighting.

Left Each guest bedroom has its own textural, neutral color palette, and is appointed with built-in furnishings equal to those in the master.







**Top Left** On the main level a floating credenza greets guests at the entry.

Above The powder room is off of the coat room which is designed with coat closet, cubby storage, and a bench for taking off and on shoes.

Left A smooth mocha concrete countertop and integral sink contrast with pristine white textured wallcovering to create drama in the powder room.





Above The design of the guest rooms is consistent with that of the master. Tile, countertops, upholstery and linens create a custom variation of the palette for each room.

Right Linear recessed fluorescent fixtures are used in the guest bedrooms and coat room for their energy efficiency and modern aesthetic.




